

Hazardous Material (Hazmat) Shipping Policy – Customer Designated Freight Forwarders

Southeast Aerospace is committed to ensuring all hazardous material shipments are handled safely and in compliance with applicable transportation regulations. To provide customers with a reliable and efficient Hazmat shipping process, Southeast Aerospace offers established Hazmat shipping services through approved carriers experienced with the handling and transportation of regulated materials.

Customers who elect to utilize their own freight forwarder or third-party shipping provider are responsible for ensuring that their selected carrier is properly qualified and authorized to handle hazardous material shipments in accordance with all applicable DOT, IATA, FAA, and international shipping regulations.

When a customer-designated freight forwarder is used:

- Southeast Aerospace will provide the required Hazmat documentation applicable to the shipment from Southeast Aerospace to the designated freight forwarder.
- The freight forwarder assumes responsibility for any additional documentation, declarations, handling requirements, routing requirements, and regulatory compliance from the freight forwarder location to the final destination.
- Southeast Aerospace is not responsible for preparing documentation, correcting paperwork, or providing compliance support for shipment segments controlled by the customer's freight forwarder.
- Any delays, rejected shipments, additional documentation requests, or compliance issues resulting from the selected freight forwarder are the responsibility of the customer and/or freight forwarder.

Due to the additional processing, coordination, documentation review, and administrative support required when using customer-designated freight forwarders, a **Hazmat Handling Fee of \$250.00 per shipment** will apply.

Additional charges may apply if extensive support, documentation revisions, shipment corrections, repackaging, or additional compliance assistance is required beyond standard Hazmat processing.

To avoid additional fees, delays, or documentation issues, Southeast Aerospace recommends utilizing our established Hazmat shipping services whenever possible.
